# Description

This is a LimeSurvey extension that extends the LDAP support offered by the core plugin.

It allows you to update full name/email on each login action.

The extension supports Groups. If the LDAP provides a group name, you can enable Sync group option to update the user group. If the group name provided does not exist yet, you can enable Auto-create groups field to generate it automatically.

The same applies to roles.

It also allows for auditing LDAP actions by enabling a logger.

## How does it work?

It works in the same way as the <u>LDAP core plugin</u>, but adds extra features.

### Pre-requisites

- Verify that phpinfo.php shows that LDAP is enabled. The location of LimeSurvey's built-in phpinfo.php is: Upper Right Menu --Configuration -- Settings -- Global Settings.
  - Then, below the table, you will have a link for "Show PHPInfo".
- Enable LDAP in php.ini.

### See PHP LDAP docs.

You don't need to activate the LDAP core plugin; instead, activate the AuthLDAPExtended plugin.

# Installation

The AuthLDAPExtended extension requires the same requisites as the core LDAP extension:

There are 2 ways to install the extension:

- Unzip and drop the files in the plugins folder
- Use the plugin Manager

### **Dropping the Files**

Copy the **AuthLDAPExtended** folder, which you will find after unzip the provided file, inside the **plugins** folder of LimeSurvey.

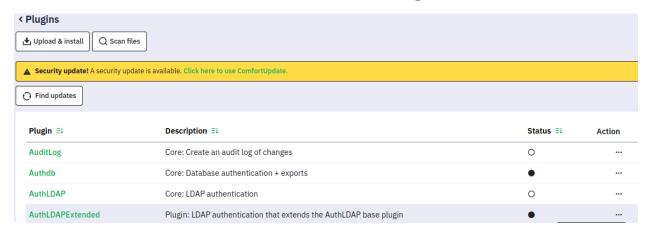
Now go to the Admin panel, Settings > Plugin Manager then click on Scan files, AuthLDAPExtended should appear, click on its install icon.

### **Plugin Manager**

In order to install the plugin go to the Admin panel. Then, access **Settings > Plugin Manager**, click on the **Upload & Install** button and select the provided zip file.

# Settings

To configure the plugin go to the Admin panel. Then access to **Settings** > **Plugin Manager**, and you will see the **AuthLDAPExtended** listed. If it is not listed, click on **Scan Files** and a view will appear where you will be able to install the extension to be recognized.



If you see the extension on the list, click on its name to access its settings configuration panel. After this process, we can go back to this list and click on the dots and select "Activate" to enable the extension.

Settings will include all settings parameters available on the LDAP core, plus new settings available at the "Extended Settings" section.

Extended Settings:	
Auto update users	If enabled, the plugin will update at Limesurvey the email address and the full name of the user, during the LDAP login process
Auto create groups	Enable it in order to allow the plugin to create new groups provided by the LDAP entry that don't exists on LimeSurvey
Sync group info	Enable it in order to sync user groups. User will have the groups provided by the LDAP entry. Old assigned groups will be removed.
Auto create roles	Enable it in order to allow the plugin to create new roles provided by the LDAP entry that don't exists on LimeSurvey
Sync role info	Enable it in order to sync user roles. User will have the roles provided by the LDAP entry. Old assigned roles will be removed.
Enable logger	Enable it to store in logs actions of the AuthLDAPExtended plugin.

If you want to sync the user data hosted on the IdP in the LimeSurvey user account, then enable the **Auto update users** field settings.

The extension supports Groups. If the IdP provides a group name that does not exist yet, you can enable **Sync group info** field to generate it automatically. It also supports Roles, which can also be autocreated and synchronized.

To be able to sync group/roles, you will need to provide information on how to identify that data at the LDAP entry by filling in the fields LDAP Attribute of group and LDAP Attribute of role.

If **Enable Logger** is enabled, then any action executed by the AuthLDAPExtended plugin gonna be registered in the logs.
